

# Height Modification Procedure

UpFarm Standard legs can be modified to change the height of the planter box in 100mm increments between 400mm and 1000mm.

This is an easy job but should be performed by someone with practical experience using a hacksaw on metal.

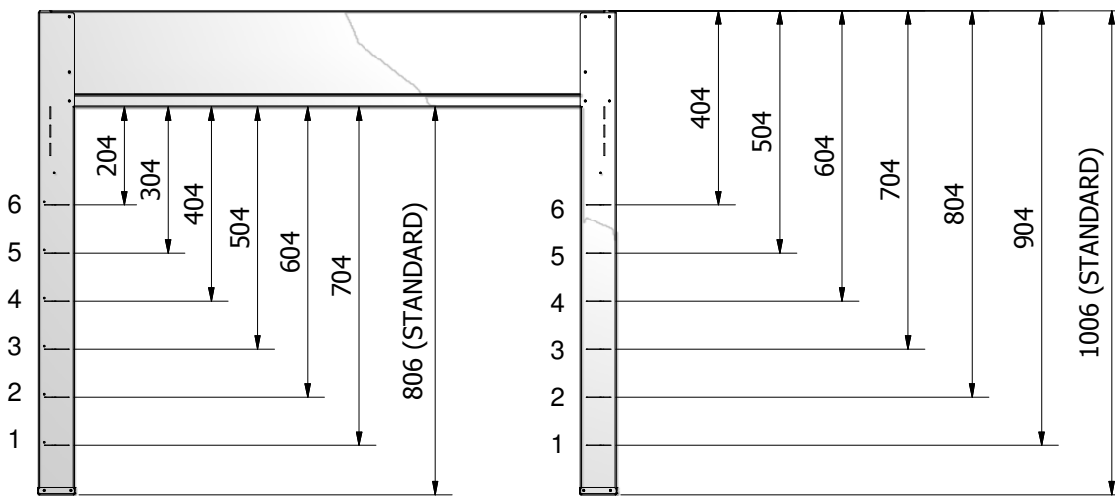
Complete the leg modification below if necessary, and then proceed with the assembly instructions over-page.

## Tools Needed

- Hacksaw
- Gloves
- Safety Glasses
- Vice or Clamp

## Procedure

- 1/ It is recommended that gloves and safety glasses be worn during this process.
- 2/ From the drawing below, select a height (either top or underside) that suits your needs. Note the number.



3/ Using a cordless drill and the driver bit provided, unscrew the leg cap (a) and put aside. If you are using cut-off point 5, also unscrew and remove leg brace (b).

4/ Put leg section in a vice, or clamp to a bench, with the cut-off point you have chosen hanging out.

5/ With the hacksaw, cut all corners in-line with the slits at the chosen cut-off point. The scrap end will come free.

6/ Push leg cap (a) back over end of leg, and screw back into place.

7/ Repeat for all four legs, ensuring you cut at the same point on each. Continue over-page.
